

Day One: Protecting Your Holiday Package Deliveries

- Ask a trusted neighbor or friend who may be home during the day if your package can be delivered to their home.
- Consider having the package sent to a local retailer.
- Provide the shipper with delivery instructions.
- Consider asking your employer if your packages can be received at your place of employment.
- Request a signature confirmation or ask the shipper to hold the package at their facility for pickup.
- Track deliveries online and sign up for notifications.
- Consider a new tool called Package Guard—a Wi-Fi-enabled device that alerts you when a package
 has been delivered to your house and sets off a loud alarm if anyone unauthorized tries to steal the
 package.
- Be neighborly and watch out for each other's packages.
- Report any unusual or suspicious behavior to the Sheriff's Office by calling 540-658-4400.
