Day Four: Vehicle Break-In Prevention

- Lock vehicles and close windows
- Keep items such as shopping bags and recent purchases out of plain site
- Remove valuables altogether if possible
- Do not store wallets, purses, or firearms in any vehicle
- Do not leave keys in vehicle
- Do not leave running vehicles unattended
- Consider an alarm
- Remember: Take it. Hide it. Lock it. Or Lose it.
