ASSAULT

The victim advised while in the parking lot her ex came out of nowhere and entered her vehicle. This resulted in a verbal altercation that escalated when the suspect assaulted the victim. The victim was able to fight off her attacker and drive off. Warrants for assault and battery, as well as, unlawful entry of a vehicle were obtained.

DRUGS

Criminal complaints for threats of death and underage possession of alcohol on school grounds were submitted.
