LARCENY

Walmart, 217 Garrisonville Road, 4/15, 11:27 a.m. Deputy S.M. Eastman responded to a larceny. Staff advised time flew out the door when two suspects stole watches. The suspects would flee the area in a "beat-up" vehicle with a New York license plate.

Armor Court, 4/15, 9:15 p.m. Deputy J.H. Helbling was responding to an unrelated call when he observed a Dodge Ram. The vehicle in question was reported stolen out of Fredericksburg. Deputy Helbling, with the assistance of Deputy C.M. Sterne, conducted a high-risk stop and detained the suspended driver. The driver was charged with possession of a stolen vehicle and driving while suspended. He was held at Rappahannock Regional Jail on a \$5,000 secured bond.

PUBLIC INTOXICATION

Sherwood Forest Farm Road, 4/15, 1:33 a.m. Deputies responded to a public intoxication call. Multiple callers advised a male was dancing in the street. Deputies quickly located the Footloose suspect and observed signs of intoxication. He was charged with public intoxication and held at Rappahannock Regional Jail until sober.
