DISTURBANCE

Rappahannock Regional Jail, 1745 Richmond Highway, 4/17, 1:39 a.m. Deputy J.J. Holetzky was in the middle of an unrelated bond hearing when an inmate began causing a disturbance. His disruption was so loud, the magistrate couldn't properly conduct the hearing. The inmate was charged with obstruction of justice.

FRAUD

Wawa, 9 South Gateway Drive, 4/17, 12:48 p.m. Deputy F.C. O'Neill was in the area when he observed a pair engaging in a verbal altercation. In an attempt to quell the situation, he made contact with the male and female. The female identified herself as "Karen." Using law enforcement databases, Deputy O'Neill discovered that this "Karen" wasn't providing her real identity. She was eventually identified and discovered to have a warrant out of Fredericksburg. She was served on her outstanding warrant and additionally charged with identity theft and providing a false identification to law enforcement. She was held at Rappahannock Regional Jail on a \$500 secured bond.

LARCENY

Stonegate Place, 4/17, 12:25 p.m. Deputy E.L. Shelton responded to a larceny. The victim advised he ordered food through DoorDash. When he went to collect his goods, they were nowhere to be found, despite the DoorDash app stating the delivery was "handed to customer."

WARRANT SERVED

Onville Road Marine Corps Gate, 4/17, 12:23 p.m. Deputy R.L. Hubbard responded to a warrant service. Marine Corps authorities had a suspect at the gate that was wanted out of Maryland for a felony. Deputy Hubbard took custody of the suspect and transported him to Rappahannock Regional Jail. He was charged with fugitive from justice and held without bond.
