## **DRUGS**

Deputy Trainor arrived and made contact with the suspect, who advised he was there to clear his head. Apparently, clearing meant filling it with narcotics, for Deputy Trainor located suspected controlled substances in his possession. The suspect admitted it was "probably molly." While thou shalt not speak evil, it appeared this individual was smoking it. He was charged with possession of controlled substances and was released by the magistrate on personal recognizance.
