LARCENY

Wawa, 105 Garrisonville Road, 6/3, 4:28 a.m. Deputy E.L. Shelton was in the area when he observed a Hyundai back into a crane. Deputy Shelton made contact with both occupants, and while doing so, noticed damages to the inside of the vehicle consistent with someone stealing it. Both the driver and the juvenile passenger were detained. Contact was made with the vehicle's owner, who confirmed it was stolen out of Maryland. The driver was charged with possession of stolen goods, driving without a license, destruction of property, and contributing to the delinquency of a minor. She was released by the magistrate on personal recognizance. A criminal complaint for possession of stolen goods was submitted for the juvenile.

Target, 25 South Gateway Drive, 6/3, 4:49 p.m. Sergeant J.D. Hurt responded to a cosmetic criminal. Staff observed a female suspect stuffing various face care products into her purse. While a healthy skin care routine is important, the nearly \$60 worth of items was recovered and she was issued a summons for shoplifting.

Area of Richmond Highway and Centreport Parkway, 6/3, 4:27 p.m. Deputies were on a traffic stop when they were flagged down by another driver. The driver advised while traveling on Centreport Parkway an unfocused Ford Focus driver began driving recklessly and threw an item at his vehicle.
