**ASSAULT**

She was once again charged with assault and battery; however, would not be walking free this time. She was held at Rappahannock Regional Jail without bond.

After numerous announcements, and mention that K-9 might be used, the suspect finally realized deputies weren't going to just give up. He would finally surrender, ending the barricade issue. He was served on his outstanding warrant and additionally charged with obstruction of justice. He was held at Rappahannock Regional Jail on a \$5,000 secured bond.
